In 1985, Miracle Flights launched in Las Vegas, Nevada as "Angel Plane" delivering blood donations to rural Nevada via small, private aircraft. Today, we are a national nonprofit with **Southwest** as our leading commercial airline partner coordinating **675 flights** each month from coast-to-coast to receive medical care at Centers of Excellence.

Miracle Flights is bridging the gap in the U.S. medical system, helping to alleviate the financial burden incurred by many of our families. Over the last year, we have aligned with strategic national partners The Parking Spot and Blacklane global chauffer service to fully complete a family's medical journey – free of charge. "Miles" the teddy bear is sold in 56 WHSmith North America (formerly Marshall Retail Group) locations across the country, helping us raise awareness and funds. In addition, WHSmith North America provides much-needed respite areas in their stores for our families who need a pause during their travel journey.

As we look to the future, Miracle Flights will continue to serve anyone flying anywhere – including working with state and local government agencies to provide our services to those traveling to receive treatment for **mental health**.



We raised **\$265,000** – a phenomenal outcome during our debut year! With the funds raised, Miracle Flights scheduled **530 flights** for children and their families to receive critical lifechanging medical care...far from home.

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
